Co-Presidents Report- Faydra Pelot- MBHS Art Show visit scheduled tonight after the meeting. The district decided not to send all of our student's information to Sacramento for the lawsuit against the California Department of Education. MB Cluster Report- Andee for Jennifer Tandy- Recent meeting was at PBE with Rubik's Cube and science presentation. Informative presentation by Wendy Ranck-Buhr, Director of Leadership and Learning at SD Unified, regarding math and science pathways from middle to high school. Some concerns about integrated Math 3 preparing students enough for AP Calculus, but MBHS is still looking at the pathway to identify what may be missing. Lots of discussion around identification for math placement in middle school. Everyone felt good about the answer to the pathway questions. MB Cluster meets the needs of it's students.
